



## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Attendance of the students in the class is very important.
- Bunking lectures under the name of outside tuitions will not be entertained and if found strict action will be taken.
- The students whose attendance is not according to the board norms would not be allowed to appear for board examination.
- It is compulsory to appear for all the examinations conducted by the college. The college reserves the right not to allow you to fill in board examination forms if you are found unsatisfactory.

- It is compulsory to converse in English so far students are in college campus.

- Students should use the campus in a nice and orderly fashion and should not hang around at the parking area.
- During the examination any kind of mal-practice is strictly prohibited. A strict action will be taken in this regard.

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- Use of any electronic gadgets (mobile phones, I-phones, I-pads etc.) is not allowed in the college campus. If found, such gadgets will be confiscated and strict action will be taken against the student.

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### Rules for BOARDERS

- **AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS STAYING IN JR. COLLEGE (CLASS 11 & 12) HOSTEL**
- 1) Hostel accommodation is granted so that students can **concentrate on studies**. In case any student's academic performance **falls below the average 60%** at the end of the year i.e. in XI Std., as prescribed by the College, **he/she will be asked to leave the Hostel**.
- 2) Students found using / engaging in Alcohol, Narcotics, Tobacco, Gambling, Ragging or Stealing will automatically be expelled from the Hostel.
- 3) **Mobile phones** will be allowed inside the Hostel premises and should only be used during the student's free time.
- 4) If a student is found using a mobile phone anywhere else it will be confiscated and repeat offenders will be expelled from the Hostel.
- 5) **Lockers are provided** to ensure safety of student's possessions. The College takes no responsibility for loss / theft of any property and we recommend that no high value items are brought into the Hostel.
- 6) Indiscipline will not be tolerated and repeat offenders will be expelled from the Hostel. Insolence or rudeness of any kind towards Boarding Section Staff will result in the student's expulsion from the Hostel.
- 7) Students are not allowed to leave the Campus in their free time but must take permission from and report back to the Master on Duty. A record of the outings must be entered in the Register kept for this purpose.
- 8) Overnight Outings will require the approval of the Jr. College Principal
- 9) All students must be present at Roll Call held at 8.30 pm. Students are not allowed to leave the campus after Dinner. If a student leaves the Campus after Dinner he will be expelled from the Hostel.
- 10) Students are not permitted to enter other dormitories and must not allow school students from other dormitories to enter the Jr. College Dormitory.
- 11) **English Speaking is mandatory at all times**. Students found talking, listening to music, watching TV programs / Movies in other languages

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will be severely dealt with. However on Sundays students may watch TV Programs / Movies and listen to music in other languages.

- 12) Students are not allowed to watch TV, also they are not allowed to go in other places to watch TV.
- 13) **No electric appliances are allowed.** However students are permitted to use mobile phone chargers.
- 14) Students are welcome to participate in sports during the evening provided that proper shoes are worn.
- 15) Girls have to follow all the rules followed by school girls in the hostel.
